

ARE YOU ON THE VOTERS' LIST?

Town of Halton Hills residents can find out whether they're on the list to vote for the upcoming municipal and school board elections by going to the Town of Halton Hills Election website <https://www.haltonhills.ca/elections> and clicking on the button 'Am I on the Voters List?'. To check and see if you are on the voters list you will need to provide your name, date of birth and address.

If you are not listed on the voters list or your information needs to be corrected please attend at the Clerks' Office - Service Halton Hills Counter, 1 Halton Hills Drive, Halton Hills and fill out an Application to Amend the Voters List Form, you must bring valid ID with you in order to have the list amended. This information will help to ensure that municipal Voters' Lists are accurate and up-to-date in preparation for the municipal and school board elections occurring October 22, 2018.

UNABLE TO MAKE IT TO THE POLLS TO VOTE? YOU CAN VOTE THROUGH PROXY

Any qualified elector in the Town of Halton Hills may appoint another person who is also a qualified elector in the Town of Halton Hills to vote on their behalf by completing a proxy form. The electors must confirm that they are on the voters list prior to submitting the Proxy form. This can be done by visiting the Town of Halton Hills Municipal Election Website <https://www.haltonhills.ca/elections/index.php>.

The form can be picked up at the Town Hall, Service Halton Hills Counter, 1 Halton Hills Drive or a Proxy Form can be mailed to you by calling (905)873-2601 ext. 2333 or ext. 2330.
