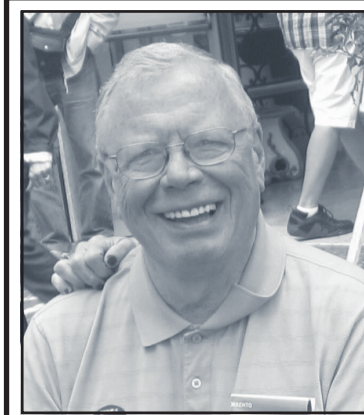


BOOTH, Marion Olive

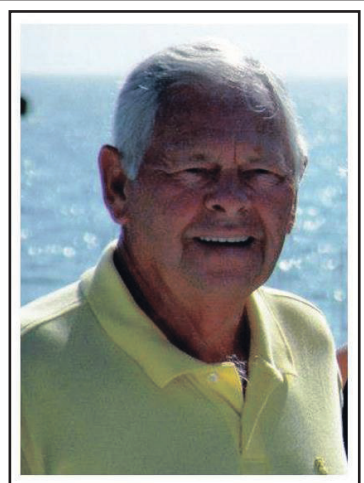
