good ones keep the not-sogood ones in check," he said. "If you go and do a clearing it's like coming home and finding your kid having a party. You come home and you're absolutely upset and you say, 'Evervbody out!' Well who leaves? It's the good ones who are like, 'Yes sir, yes ma'am, sorry, sorry,' and leave, but sometimes the not-so-great ones are brooding in the corner and not listening."

Roe adds that he and the team perform all their tasks with safety in mind and permission from their clients, from investigating sites to publicly releasing information.

"If there are any properties owned by heritage committees, or others who are at all curious about their properties, we are open to being invited to check them out," he said.

"I would encourage that from a heritage and history point of view. I think adding a ghost to your historical property will pique the interest of many more people."

On Oct. 21, Roe will be conducting a Searcher Group fundraising presentation for Heritage Acton, where he will be discussing the findings of the sixpart investigation, as chronicled in his book, as well as speaking about his work, his methods and Searcher Group founder Richard Palmisano's groundbreaking theories on life-after-life phenome-

Roe added that his intention with his new publication is to make readers feel that they are a part of the investigation.

"I wanted to take people

on a ride with us basically," he said. "Certainly there's some creepy moments, but I'm hoping that they'll take away that there's more to life beyond our five-sense reality."
