## ■ NEWS 'HOW CAN YOU LEAVE SOMEONE LYING THERE?' GEORGETOWN MOTHER SEEKING ANSWERS AFTER DRIVER HITS SON ON BICYCLE

A Georgetown mother is hoping witnesses will come forward after a driver hit her son while he was riding his bicycle Thursday night (Nov. 15) and fled the scene.

"It's been a very long night," said Rachel Bryan-Maloney, who took her 13year-old son to hospital after he came home confused, disoriented and soaking wet.

He was riding his bicycle, making a left-hand turn at the intersection of Delrex Boulevard and Faludon Drive at around 7:15 p.m. when a blue two-door vehicle struck him.

"He actually flipped over the handlebars and fell," Bryan-Maloney said, adding that he sustained deep bruising and swelling bike on Faludon Drive near Delrex Boulevard on Thursday night.
