

CATHOLIC SCHOOL BOARD INVITES MEMBERS TO SPECIAL EDUCATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The Halton Catholic District School Board invites incorporated parents' associations and community members at large, to apply for membership to its Special Education Advisory Committee.

The mandate of the special education advisory committee (SEAC) is to make recommendations to the board about matters affecting special education programs and services delivered to students with exceptional needs.

SEAC consists of members nominated by local community associations and approved by the board.

There are up to 12 positions available for local parent associations, and up to two positions available for community members, for the 2018-2022 term.

The community associations have pa-



rental representatives who promote the interests and well-being of students with exceptional needs and abilities, and must operate locally within the jurisdiction of the Halton Catholic District School Board (HCDSB).

SEAC meets on the last Monday of every month at the Catholic Education Centre in Burlington.

The deadline for submissions is Friday, Nov. 30. Those interested in applying as a "member at large" must be:

- Canadian citizen, 18 years of age or older
 - Resident within the jurisdiction of the HCDSB
 - A registered Catholic school supporter
- Board employees are not eligible for appointment.
