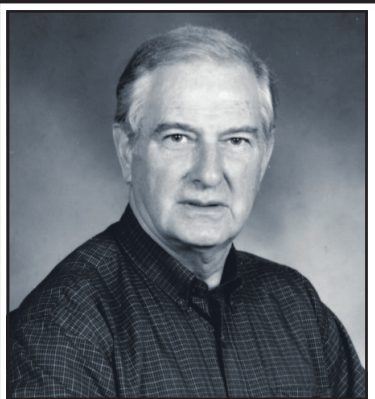

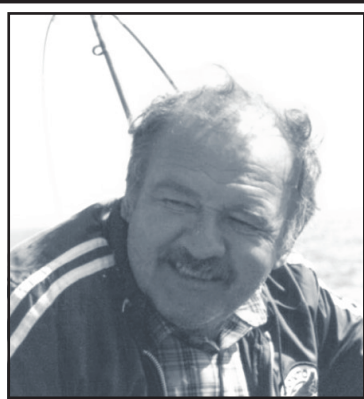

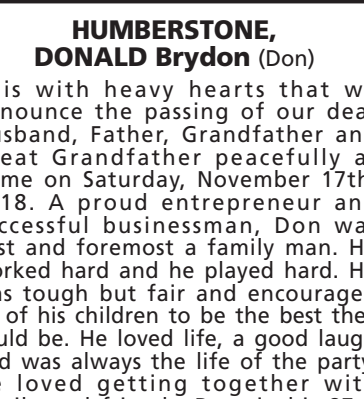
BECKETT, Ben

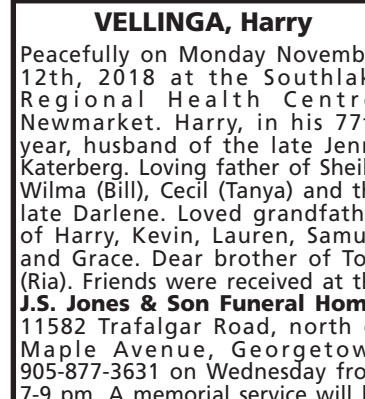
