With the legalization of cannabis still just a few weeks old, there remains no shortage of questions about exactly what is now permitted and where.

Const. Ryan Smith of the Halton police community mobilization bureau recently outlined some of the basic changes that came from the legalization of recreational cannabis in Canada on Oct. 17.
