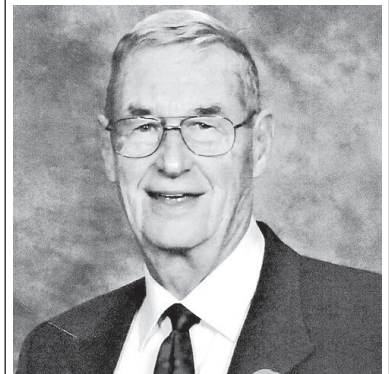
*His wit and sense of humour

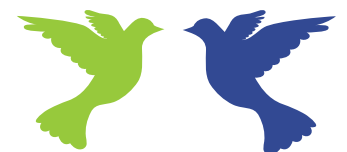
