

Some Norval residents are petitioning against the Lucy Maud Montgomery Museum and Literary Centre proposed to be developed at 402 and 404 Draper St.

SOME OBJECTING BUT ORGANIZERS SAY MONTGOMERY MUSEUM WILL GO AHEAD

Last month, a petition was presented to council signed by dozens of Norval residents in opposition of proposed development projects in the hamlet, including future plans for the Lucy Maud Montgomery Museum and Literary Centre, but Lois Fraser, president of the Heritage Foundation of Halton Hills, says the project will be moving forward.

On Dec. 11 at the Town's Community and Corporate Affairs Committee meeting, longtime

Norval resident Pauline Gladstone gave a delegation on behalf of 61 Norval residents. It specifically outlined the aspects of the plan proposed by Norval Community Association that the group deems a concern: the development of the Lucy Maud Montgomery Muse-

um and Literary Centre at 402 and 404 Draper St. (properties also known as the Norval Manse and Cottage), the removal or modification of the Norval Park baseball diamond to facilitate a war memorial, the addi-
