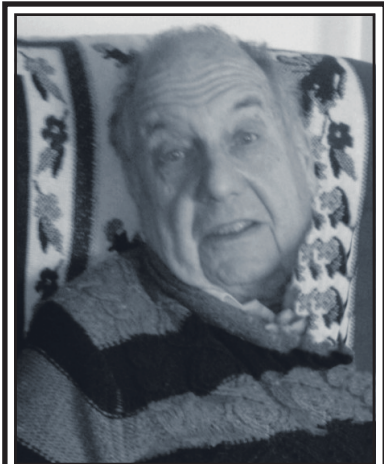
GLASS, John Watson
