Norval United Church is building its new church on the corner of Eighth Line and Danby Road in Georgetown. The church is the first of three phases to be built on the five-acre property.

Norval United Church will be on the move later this year.

The new 15,000-square-foot church is being built on the corner of Eighth Line and Danby Road, between Gellert Community Centre and the Halton Hills fire department's headquarters. It will replace the current church at 486 Guelph St. in the village of Norval that was built in the late

JUST THE FACTS:

- · Construction is expected to be completed by the end of July, and Rev. Paul Ivany hopes to be in the new church by Thanksgiving.
- · Ivany said the move was necessary to continue to offer the services the church provides and to expand on them. "We've outgrown our space," he said. "It's a wonderful building, but it's no longer practical for the services we offer. It's 130 years old. It was built before electricity and cars."
- The new church will include a 400-seat sanctuary, a full-sized gymnasium, a fully

serviced kitchen, a 56-seat chapel, six meeting rooms and will be fully accessible, with everything on the ground level.

- The church is being built on a five-acre property and is the first of three phases.
- · The second phase will include a banquet hall, as well as meeting and office space that can be utilized by community service groups so people don't have to travel to Oakville or Burlington. "There are groups that need to be in Georgetown for a day or half a day a week," Rev. Ivany said. "We want to create a community hub where a number of groups can come together in one building."
- · Among the potential uses for the third phase is affordable housing for seniors.
- "People say nobody builds churches anymore," Rev. Ivany said. "We're an outward-looking congregation. We want to build a community. This will allow us to serve and give back to the community even more."
