'Our food is a little more elevated from your typical pub food and it's fresh, of course, and inhouse made," Emanuele said, adding that Appalachian is in the process of changing up its menu.

The new offerings will include a Creole stir fry, mushroom alfredo linguine, bacon-wrapped meat loaf and a 10-ounce striploin steak dinner.
