Plan some FAMILY Day FUN in HALTON HILLS and beyond

Mountsberg Conservation Area

Whether you prefer to stay indoors or get outside, Family Day, and the weekend leading up to Monday, Feb. 18, offers us the opportunity to spend some extra time together. It's also a great time to explore Halton Hills and surrounding areas with a variety of special events offered across the community and beyond.

On Saturday, Feb. 16, attend the Terra Cotta Moonlight Event from 6 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. Enjoy an evening of skiing, snowshoeing and skating under the stars at Terra Cotta Conservation Area. Explore snow-covered trails or glide across a torchlit Wolf Lake. Warm up by a campfire with a hot beverage and enjoy Ontario's winter wonderland at night. Don't forget your headlamp! Family Day weekend is also your last chance to enjoy Winter Sleigh Rides at Mountsberg Conservation Area. This annual winter event encourages families to get outside and tour the Conservation Area's winter wonderland. Sleigh Rides run between 10:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. but Mountsberg's other attractions, including the Discovery Centre and Play Barn are open all day.

If getting outside with the family is on your list of things to do, skiing or snowboarding at Kelso is a fun option.



Bronte Creek Provincial Park

Featuring 17 runs and seven lifts it's an enjoyable hill for all levels and is open all Family Day Weekend long.

On Monday join in the Bruce Trail, Halton Hills Chapter, Family Day Hike. This hike is moderate pace, easy to moderate terrain and will make a loop through Limehouse Conservation Area and along the Black Creek Side Trail. The hike is approx 2.7 km. Meet at the southeast corner of the Georgetown Marketplace parking lot at 10 a.m.

Also on Monday, tour the various barns and outbuildings at Bronte Creek Provincial Park where you can see your favourite farm animals in the Children's Farm or climb, jump and explore tunnels in the Children's Playbarn. In the Nature Centre, live animals and hands on displays showcase the park's natural world. Hands-on nature and heritage crafts will also be offered.

On Family Day, the Town of Halton Hills presents a variety of family events. Visit haltonhills.ca/familyday/ for a schedule of events including skating, swimming, sportball, family stick and puck, crafts, Monkeynastix, yoga, storytime, drop-in Lego, scavenger hunt, and board games at several locations in Georgetown and Acton.
