Five unique tags have been recognized based on their style and signature, each using a different colour and distinct style of writing. The five identifiable tags are:

- Deadx (normally painted in black)
- Dead (contains a scythe extending on the last letter)
- Jade (normally painted in black and written in cursive)
- RIOT (written in all capitals and normally

painted in red)
