Halton council is sending a strong message to Queen's Park opposing any potential municipal amalgamation that could result from the current regional government review.

In a unanimous vote on Wednesday, March 27, regional councillors passed a motion supporting the current two-tier municipal government in Halton

The resolution put forth by Burlington Mayor Marianne Meed Ward goes on to assert that any changes by the province to the local structure would be "disruptive and wasteful."

"Our essential message to the province is, don't fix what's
