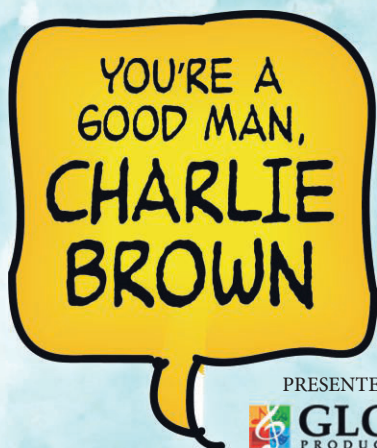

## HALTON HILLS PUBLIC LIBRARY HOSTS #HCCREADS

The Halton Climate Collective is hosting a one-hour launch at the Georgetown branch of the Halton Hills Public Library.

The Halton Climate Collective (HCC) is focused on educating and transforming Halton into a low-carbon, climate-resilient community. To achieve this, the organization is leading a community-wide campaign called #HCCReads across Halton's public libraries in Milton, Burlington, Halton Hills, and Oakville.

At the event the HCC will lead a discussion of the #HCCReads selected book, *Drawdown: The Most Comprehensive Plan Ever Proposed to Reverse Global Warming*, by Paul Hawken. The book explores 100 carefully vetted technological, social, and ecological solutions from various scholars, scientists, entrepreneurs, and advocates committed to reducing atmospheric carbon within the next 30 years.
