## HALTON HILLS PUBLIC LIBRARY HOSTS #HCCREADS

The Halton Climate Collective is hosting a one-hour launch at the Georgetown branch of the Halton Hills Public Library.

The Halton Climate Collective (HCC) is focused on educating and transforming Halton into a low-carbon, climate-resilient community. To achieve this, the organization is leading a community-wide campaign called #HCCReads across Halton's public libraries in Milton, Burlington, Halton Hills, and Oakville.

At the event the HCC will lead a discussion of the #HCCReads selected book, Drawdown: The Most Comprehensive Plan Ever Proposed to Reverse Global Warming, by Paul Hawken. The book explores 100 carefully vetted technological, social, and ecological solutions from various scholars, scientists, entrepreneurs, and advocates committed to reducing atmospheric carbon within the next 30 years.
