THE CELLAR STEAK AND SEAFOOD REOPENS IN DOWNTOWN GEORGETOWN

An iconic Georgetown restaurant is returning under new ownership, but downtown shoppers haven't noticed any signs on the windows - mainly because this venue has none.

Allison Craig, new owner of The Cellar Steak and Seafood, said she'd had her eye on the downtown Georgetown business for years.

"I always felt sad I wasn't able to jump on the opportunity [when it was sold previously]," Craig said.

Craig said diners can expect to see some changes to the menu.

"The menu was on the high end, and that makes sense for the space," Craig said, "but I wanted to make it a little more appealing to families."

A few sandwiches, a burger, and steak frites are notable additions, paving the way for The Cellar to open for lunch.

"The menu is going to be bigger," Craig said. "But it's not a big menu."

With 22 years in the hospitality industry in Georgetown, Craig said she is confident in what she plans to provide.

"I have confidence in the people I've hired, and I love what I've done with the space," Craig said.

Located in the Old Bank Building - built in 1918, in downtown Georgetown - the restaurant's name, The Cellar, says it all. The unique venue is rich and
