• small drinking-water system inspections and advisories

"This enhancement will include the posting of a summary of inspection report on-site to assist the public in making informed choices," explained commissioner and medical officer of health Dr. Hamidah Meghani in a memo to regional council.

"By enhancing our disclosure system, the health department is working to support transparency in the public sector and promote public confidence in the public health system."

Similar to Halton's Dine-wise program, a public health inspector will issue both an inspection report and summary of inspection

report to the operator upon completion, said Meghani.

"The summary of inspection report will outline the areas of assessment and indicate whether the premises was in compliance with applicable legislation," she said. "If a re-inspection is required, the report would also indicate when the public health inspector will follow up to ensure items of non-compliance are corrected."

are available upon request through halton.ca and by calling 311.

Health department officials say they're also reviewing the option of posting the results online.

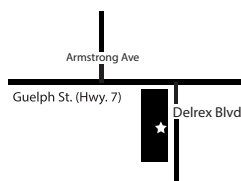
