The Georgetown Fall Fair is put on by the Georgetown Agricultural Society. While the fair is held to promote local agriculture, a variety of entertainment is scheduled throughout the weekend, including a demolition derby on Saturday night, live music, a magician and midway rides.

The festival runs from Sept. 6 to 8.

Tickets to the fair are \$8 on Friday for adults, \$10 on Saturday and Sunday. Children seven to 12 years old are \$3, and children six and under are free. An all-day pass for three people is \$25.
