Truthfully, I find that I am actually aghast

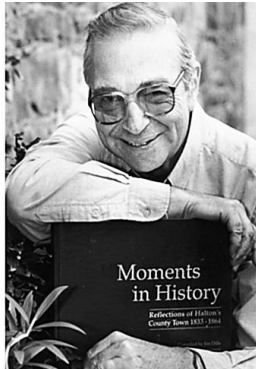
The time has now come, it's so hard to believe

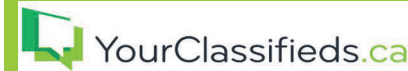
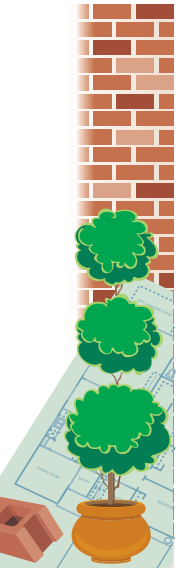
