The event's namesake, Kathryn Stewart, is a 16-year-old Georgetown resident who has been fighting cancer for the majority of her life. At age five, she was diagnosed with stage 4 neuroblastoma, a childhood cancer of the nervous system.

The disease has returned four times since then, with Kathryn enduring countless treatments, surgeries and tests over the past decade. She's currently undergoing a new trial

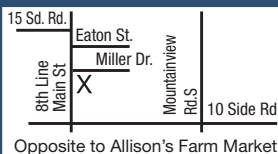
