province for years on the bypass, with little to show.

"If Hidden Quarry gets ₽ approved by LPAT (Local Planning Appeal Tribunal), there will be 26 twoway truck trips an hour [through Acton]," Bonnette said.

A study completed for James Dick Construction Ltd. by Cole Engineering Group indicated of these 26 trips to and from the quarry, 95 per cent would travel east on Highway 7 through Halton Hills.

Additionally, the town had considered a monitoring station for heavy trucks passing through Acton's core to ensure safety.
