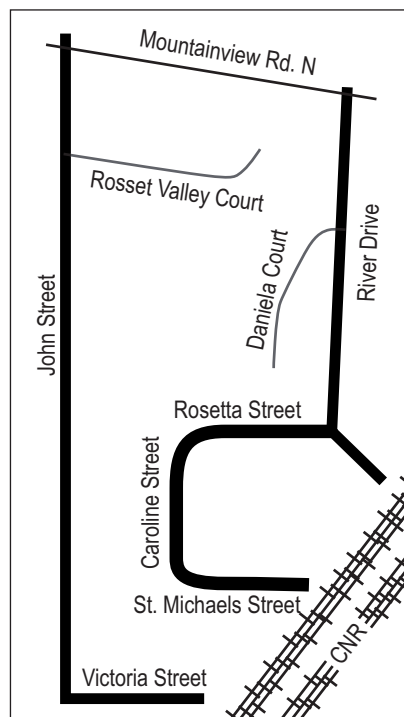
The Town of Halton Hills is reviewing potential traffic calming improvements to the following streets:
