The Christmas spirit in Halton Hills is set to shine at the annual Light Up the Hills ignition night on Dec. 1. Festivities in Georgetown's Dominion Gardens Park and at the Acton Sports Park will kick off at 5:30 p.m., while the evening in Glen Williams will get underway at 6 p.m. in the Shelagh Law Parkette.

The Light Up the Hills volunteers have been busy getting the parks ready for the big night, with all lights being turned on at 7 p.m.

This year, 100,000 LED lights will be illuminating the three parks. There will be 300 lighted trees, many illuminated displays and decorated light poles.

There will also be over 500 memory balls on display at Dominion Gardens on three Memory Trees, where local residents can pause to reflect and remember their loved ones.
