VULNERABLE RESIDENTS PROGRAMS GET FUNDING BOOST

Halton Region is dishing out funds to several organizations that assist local seniors, youth and those at risk of homelessness.

More than \$300,000 is being given to five community organizations through the Halton Region Community Investment Fund (HRCIF).

The \$316,000 earmarked for community safety and well-being initiatives will be provided to:

- Home Suite Hope to develop a pilot project that enhances access to life skills programming for individuals at risk of homelessness

- Links2Care to identify and support older adults who are isolated or at-risk of isolation

- Community Development Halton to enhance

the Halton Senior Connectors program, which offers resources and referrals for older adults

- Oakville Meals on Wheels to support the agency's ongoing operations of delivering meals to older adults and preventing isolation

- Halton Children's Aid Society (CAS) to create two housing opportunities through the Halton CAS Host Home program.

"Since 2012, the HRCIF has been helping enhance how our communities support the health, safety and well-being of our residents," said regional chair Gary Carr. "This investment will help continue that work by addressing community safety and well-being priority issues in Halton, including home-

lessness prevention, isolation among older adults and support for youth exiting child welfare services."

In 2019, the HRCIF has awarded nearly \$2.7 million in funding to a wide range of non-profit health and social service programs. These community partners and many other organizations from across Halton continue to work closely with the region and Halton regional police to implement strategies that support the health, safety and well-being of residents.
