For the one we loved so well.

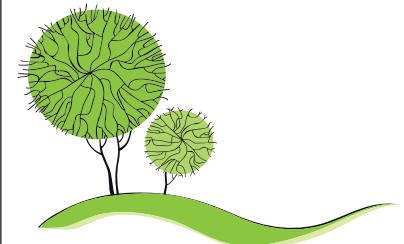
