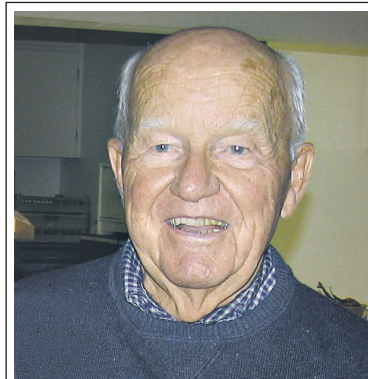

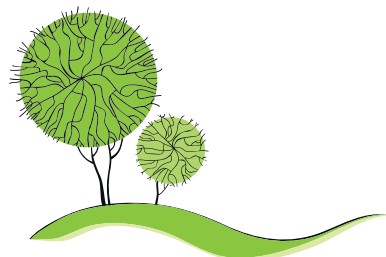
**MUIR, Stanley Gordon**
