#### WHO SHOULD I CHOOSE TO BE MY EXECUTOR?

Wills, Powers of Attorney, Trusts, Estate Litigation and Administration, Corporate, Real Estate Most individuals choose an individual estate trustee, such as a friend or family member. This option is often preferred as they know you and your circumstances

and have your best interests in mind. Since the role of an estate trustee can be very demanding, you should be sure that the person is willing and capable of carrying out the responsibilities of executor.

A corporate executor such as a trust company may be desirable where the estate is large or complex, a conflict within the family is likely, or if a long-term commitment is involved, such as administering a trust for children or a disabled beneficiary.
