KOPERDRAAD, Pietrus "Peter" Johannes

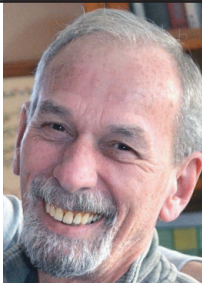
