She is now ready to find her furever family.

Mouffette is a low maintenance girl who loves attention from her people. She doesn't have the typical energy of a young cat. She enjoys playing for a short time, and then will push her head into your hand for some scratches and rubs behind the ears. One of her favourite things to do is to sit on the window sill and watch the birds fly by. Although she enjoys looking outside, she does not attempt to get out. She is happy and content indoors.

Mouffette likes to curl up beside people, but doesn't typically sleep or sit on laps. Her preferred sleeping spot is at the top of the cat tree. She tolerates being picked up but prefers to follow you around with her feet on the floor. When she wants attention, she will meow and talk until you answer her. She is a chatty cat. Mouffette is still getting used to playing and living in a home. She wants to be where her people are, but she still startles easily if she hears a loud noise, or if you approach her unexpectedly.
