

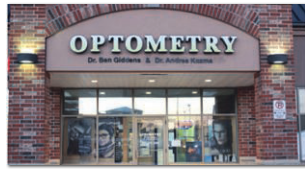

SUSPECT SOUGHT IN NORVAL ARSON

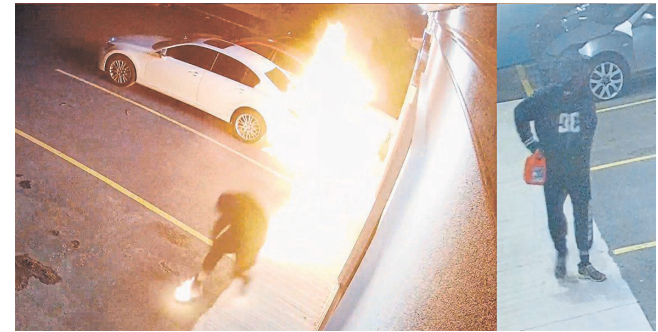

Halton Regional Police Service are conducting an arson investigation after several vehicles were intentionally set on fire on Monday, May 11.

On May 11, shortly after 10:15 p.m. police responded to a report of vehicles on fire in front of GT Auto (546 Guelph St.).

Investigators determined the vehicles were intentionally set on fire and are investigating the incident as arson. The fire was quickly extinguished and there was no damage to the business or surrounding structures.

Surveillance video obtained by police show a suspect pouring what police believe to be gas on the vehicles and lighting them on fire. In the process, the suspect also appears to have

"lit one of his feet on fire," police said in a release. He was last seen running west across the front of the business towards Louisa Street.

The suspect is a man and was wearing a black hoodie and black sweat pants at the time.

A vehicle of interest was also identified: a gold or silver four-door sedan, possibly a Honda Prelude or Ac-

cord.

Police are asking anyone in the area of Guelph St. or Louisa St. at the time of the incident who may have dashcam footage to contact Det. Cst. Sorrell or Det. Maltar at 905-825-4747 ext. 2416.
