

## **BELL TIMES CHANGING FOR** MANY PUBLIC SCHOOLS

Bell times at 18 schools within the Halton District School Board will be al-

Route efficiencies, safety concerns, and the board's efforts to steamline school hours with two, 40minute nutritional breaks (instead of one 50-minute and one 40-minute break) at all elementary schools over the next couple of years, are behind the ad-

**Public** School: 9:25 a.m.-3:45 p.m. The only high school on the list is Craig Kielburger Secondary School which will see a slight adjustment in its bell times: 8 a.m.-2:34 p.m. to address safety concerns with the nearby French Catholic elementary school.

Oakville trustee Kelly Amos voiced concern that no adjustment was made for delayed starting times for high school students, to accommodate teen sleep patterns which conflict with early bell times.

"To do what's best for students and have them all learn the best, we have to try and make some accommodation at some point,' said Amos.

Up to 40 schools could be impacted by one high school bell time change, so it's a more complex process, said Roxana Negoi, Superintendent of Business Services.

With the bell time changes there is an anticipated savings of almost \$500,000.
