## Notice of Passage - By-law 2020-0037



**TAKE NOTICE** that the Council for the Corporation of the Town of Halton Hills has passed temporary By-law No. 2020-0037, requiring the mandatory wearing of a mask/face coverings in enclosed public places during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Council for the Town of Halton Hills has the authority to enact by-laws, pursuant to Section 11 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001 c. 25 as amended, with respect to economic, social and environmental well-being of the municipality, including respecting climate change; the health, safety and well-being of persons; and the protection of persons and property, including consumer protection.

Based on a growing body of evidence outlining the effectiveness of a mask or face covering to act as a barrier to prevent the spread of COVID-19 to others, the Council for the Town of Halton Hills deems it necessary to implement a requirement for persons to wear a mask or face covering while in certain enclosed public places/spaces to assist in reducing the spread of COVID-19 within the Town of Halton Hills.

Residents are reminded that masks/face coverings should be used alongside other public health protocols including frequent hand washing, physical distancing and staying home if ill.
