

PUBLIC BOARD REVISES SCHOOL YEAR CALENDAR

The Halton District School Board has tweaked its proposed 2020/2021 school year calendar, which was initially released at the March 25 board meeting.

The revised calendar moves the Oct. 9 PA day (Thanksgiving weekend) to Sept. 1, providing three PA days prior to Labour Day at both the elementary and secondary school level.

"The primary reason is, with the uncertainty of what school will look like in the fall, this will provide some additional time for staff to learn about the COVID-related health and safety protocols that will need to be in place now that kids and staff are back in the building, learn about the return to school learning model (which hasn't been finalized yet), to ensure plans are in place for high needs students transitioning back to school after an extended absence ..." explained Associate Director of Education, David Boag.

The last day of the school year will now be June 29, 2021, which will also move the

secondary PA day on June 30 to June 29. Second semester exams will be scheduled for June 21-25.

The first day of school is Tuesday, Sept.

Trustees voted unanimously on the changes at a special meeting of the board July 9.
