INTERNET SERVICE WOES PERSIST IN RURAL AREAS

Halton is once again pushing the federal and provincial governments for immediate action to ensure basic internet service is accessible to everyone, including rural residents.

It's been talked about for over a decade, but the lack of high-speed (broadband) internet availability for many living in the region's countryside remains a problem.

The issue has been under-

scored by the pandemic, which has seen local families who live outside town struggle to complete their work and school assignments with inadequate internet service.

"This had a huge impact on elearning. My children had a hard time joining class conferences," said local mother Jen Soares, who lives north of Georgetown. "Prior to moving rurally, I had no idea what an atrocity internet is here and how
