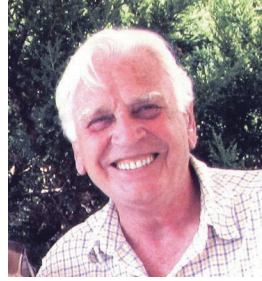
BRUCE (NEE Dunn), Barb
