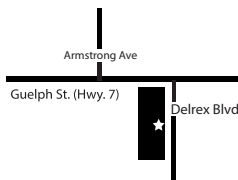

CATHOLIC BOARD APPROVES SCHOOL YEAR BUDGET

The Halton Catholic District School Board's 2020-21 budget has been approved.

We have a budget.

The Halton Catholic District School Board approved the 2020 to 2021 budget in the amount of \$444,972,964 on July 29. The approved budget outlines an operating surplus of \$469,000.

Expected enrolments for the coming year are 23,903 elementary students and 13,249 secondary students. That represents an overall increase in student enrolment of 1.9 per cent.

A total of 45.5 staff positions will be added for the 2020-2021 school year, including 22 new elementa-

ry teachers, 21.5 new secondary teachers, and one new school support staff.

The Halton Catholic District School Board operates 45 elementary schools, nine secondary schools, three continuing education facilities and has a population of more than 36,000 students across the region.
