## FAIRY LAKE DAM REHABILITATION UNDERWAY

The Fairy Lake dam is undergoing a rehabilitation as part of a water-taking expansion planned for Prospect Park.

## JUST THE FACTS

- Water elevation levels will not change once the project is complete.
- A wooden viewing deck over the dam would have been installed this summer, but due to COVID-19 supply issues, the viewing deck will be added next spring at a cost of just over \$70,000.
- The dam rehabilitation is a Region-funded project, but led by the Town of Halton Hills as the dam is town-owned.
- The region is providing \$617,364.70, while the town is providing

\$246,502.50

- The rehabilitation should be complete in September.
- Rehabilitation includes concrete repairs, replacement of stop logs and a clay liner at the bottom of the lake.
- Stop logs will ensure the flow into

Black Creek is maintained as it benefits the natural environment downstream.

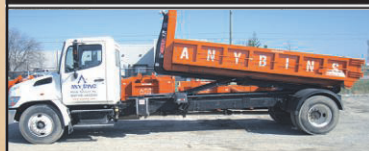
- An Armour Stone retaining wall will also be installed to support the slope between the dam and Mill Street West.
