## FEES CUT IN HALF TO HELP AQUATIC GROUPS' RESTART

## STRICT LIMITATIONS IN PLACE DURING PANDEMIC

Halton Hills aquatics groups will get a 50 per cent reduction in facility rental rates from now until June to offset limitations imposed by COVID-19.

As a directive of Swim Canada, pools may only allow two swimmers per lane, which limits aquatic groups in Halton Hills to a maximum of 12 swimmers at a time.

"When you're used to having upwards of 20 in the pool, that significantly impacts us financially," Brenna Thompson, head coach for the Halton Hills Synchronized Swimming Club, said. On Sept. 1, Halton Hills Town


