CULTURE DAYS EXPANDS TO MONTH-LONG CELEBRATION

FEATURES SELF-GUIDED PROGRAMMING, LIVESTREAMING AND IN-PERSON EVENTS

This year will have a lot more days of culture in Halton Hills, as Culture Days will expand to become a month-long event.

Culture Days runs from Sept. 25 until Oct. 25, with events and programs celebrating local arts and culture.

There will be over 60 free events, including self-guided and digital programming and in-person events that observe health and safety protocols.

"Culture Days has become a highly anticipated part of our fall calendar in Halton Hills," Mayor Rick Bonnette said in a prepared release.

"This year, in addition to offering unique, creative experiences for everyone at all ages and ability levels, it is also an opportunity to come together and show support for our arts and culture community - a sector that has faced unprecedented challenges over the past six months."

This year's event will let participants tailor the event to their own schedule and will include four categories of activities: self-guided, digital recordings, livestreams and in person.

Self-guided activities include tours and themed

scavenger hunts.

Pre-recorded music, dance and live painting performances will be a part of the "Centre Stage at the JET" series, as well as an exclusive interview series featuring artist Ingrid Mayrhofer, Helson Gallery curator Judy Daley and recording artist Promise Shepherd.

Livestreams will include "An Evening with Michelle Good," presented by the library, and artist Lisa Cafaro and Olga de Wid of the Furnace Room Brewery delving into local myths and legends.

In-person events will include Trivia Night at the youth centres, the Helson Gallery's Creative Outlets and the Halton Hills Public Library's Moccasin Identifier Project.
