Supplemental Discussion Paper

We are looking for feedback on a new supplemental discussion paper about the Major Transit Station Area and Urban Growth Centre in Downtown Burlington. The Region has been working with the City of Burlington to reconsider the Major Transit Station Area designation and to examine options to adjust the Urban Growth Centre boundary to generally align with lands around the Burlington GO Station.
