By sorting your materials properly, the compost material will be a better product.




## **Acceptable yard waste materials**

- Pumpkins (remove candles and decorations)
- Leaves
- Twigs and sticks
- Cornstalks
- Fallen fruit from trees
- Garden and tree trimmings



# **Unacceptable materials**







Plastic plant pots and trays.



Grass clippings, sod, tree stumps, soil, clay or rocks.

Yard waste collection will resume in April 2021. Yard waste can be dropped off year-round at the Halton Waste Management Site for composting. Visit **halton.ca/waste** for more information, fees, and instructions.
