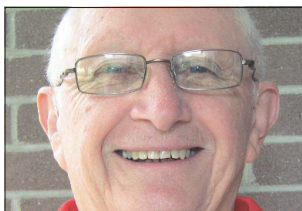

Your board, committee members and program conveyors would like to wish you a very Merry Christmas and a happy and safe new year.


