WEEKLY ROUNDUP: ACTIVE CASES CLIMB 20 PER CENT

The number of active cases of COVID-19 in Halton Region grew by more than 20 per cent over the past week and almost doubled in the city of Burlington.

The number of active cases in the region climbed from 477 to 580, most of that in Burlington, which went from 97 active cases a week ago, to 185. Oakville had an increase of 19, from 147 to 166 and Halton Hills went up by nine, from 65 to 74. Milton actually saw a decrease from 168 to 155.

The region reported eight deaths over the past week, bringing the total since the beginning of the pandemic to 108.

There are 60 people hospitalized with COVID-19 in Halton, up from 41 a week ago. The number of people infected with the vi-

rus in intensive care units doubled from nine to 18.

The region's hospitals also moved closer to capacity. The occupancy rate stands at 96.1 per cent, up from 85.8 per cent last week. ICU capacity rose from 80.4 per cent to 89.3 per cent.

The seven-day average of new cases went up from 74.4 cases per day a week ago, to 84.9. Burlington saw a sharp rise from 16.1 to 27.1 over the past seven days. Milton saw a slight increase from 24.1 to 25.0. Two municipalities did see decreases with Oakville dipping slightly to 23.6, down 0.3 from the previous week, while Halton Hills went from 10.3 to 9.1.
