

NEWS VISITOR RESTRICTIONS IN PLACE AT HOSPITALS

Visiting guidelines have been further restricted at Halton Healthcare hospitals, which includes Georgetown Hospital, Oakville Trafalgar Memorial Hospital and Milton District Hospital.

As a result of the new provincial lockdown measures, patients are required to choose one person to be their designated visitor. Patients will not be allowed to switch designated visitors.

Individuals not on the designated visitor list at the screening desks, are not permitted to enter.

For most patient units, the designated visitor will be allowed to visit once each day within one of these visiting times: 11 a.m.-2 p.m. or 4-7 p.m. Mental health inpatient visiting hours are 5-7 p.m.

"In light of the new provincial lockdown measures announced by the government and to help limit the number of people in our hospitals, we have made the difficult decision to further reduce visiting for our patients," read a statement on the HH website.

COVID-19 patients and those waiting for COVID-19

test results are not permitted visitors unless their medical status changes for the worse.

Virtual visits are offered seven days a week between 9 a.m.-9 p.m. To book a virtual visit, click here or call 905-338-4615.

All visitors are required to enter through a designated visitor entrance, go through a screening process, wear a mask at all times and remain in the patient room for the duration of their visit.

Once the Student Registration Form is received by the school contact, the school will acknowledge receipt of the Student Registration Form and share the process for providing the mandatory documents to enter your child(ren) in the system. These include:

- 1. Proof of child's age: birth certificate/passport/baptismal/faith record
- 2. Proof of address (any two of the following documents): lease or deed, car registration, utility bill, residential telephone bill, moving bill, property tax bill, bank statement, credit card statement, correspondence with a government agency
- 3. Proof of child's citizenship: birth certificate or passport, Record of Landing (IMM 1000) or Permanent Resident Card
- 4. Proof of custody: if you are not the parent and your child is under 18 you must provide proof of custody (court order)
- Please note: If your child is currently attending Junior Kindergarten in the HDSB, you do not need to register for Senior Kindergarten.
