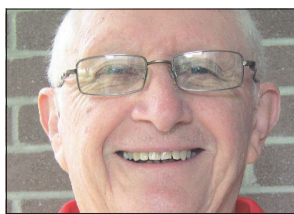


A TRULY GREAT PART OF OUR CENTRE
