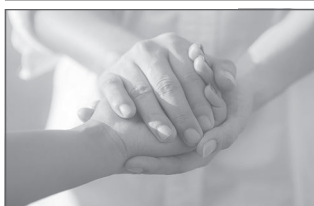
**WORRALL, James Edward**
