NEWS KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATIONS **BEING ACCEPTED**

The Halton District School Board (HDSB) is now accepting registrations for junior and senior kindergarten for Sept. 2021.

Parents are asked to register their child by Feb. 5.

Registration will be by appointment only — in-person and/or virtual — and families are asked to contact their local elementary school to find out which dates have been scheduled.

You can determine your home school or find a registration form at www.hdsb.ca.

If you hold a work permit and are registering your child for the first time with HDSB, if either the parent or child has a study permit/visa, or if the parent is a permanent resident applicant on visitor status, families should contact the HDSB Welcome Centre.

When registering, you should have the following original documents:

Proof of address; proof of age; proof

of citizenship and if you are not the child's parent, or if you have sole custody, bring proof of custody (court order).

To register to begin school in this fall, junior kindergarten (Year 1) children must be four years old by Dec. 31, 2021, and senior kindergarten (Year 2) children must be five years old by Dec. 31, 2021.

At www.kindergarten.hdsb.ca, future students can explore a kindergarten classroom to see what their classroom will look like. There are videos to watch, pictures to view and activities. Parents/guardians can learn about the kindergarten program, play-based learning, community resources and before- and after-school care. Families can also sign up to receive a welcome package from the board.
