January 11, 2021

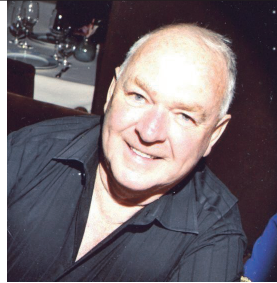

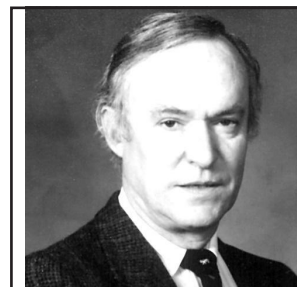
